## 10 Questions to Ask a Dealer When Buying an Outdoor Building (And Our Answers at Beaulier Buildings)

- 1. How long does it take to get the building? Our buildings are in stock and available for immediate delivery. No need to wait to have it constructed. Yes, even for a garage sized building!! Just think, a new garage in just a few days. Your vehicle will thank you.
- 2. Will it hold my vehicle? Yes, any building that is 12' or 14' wide is built to withstand a heavy vehicle.
- 3. What site preparation do I need? All you have to do is have a level spot, gravel or grass. There is no need for a concrete slab nor is the building put up on blocks. It is placed directly on the ground, on treated runners, for the best wear.
- 4. **If I move, can I have the building moved as well?** Yes, we will move buildings for a fee.
- 5. **Does the building come fully assembled?** Yes, all of our buildings are fully assembled, never in kit form, ensuring a quality product.
- 6. **Are the buildings secure?** Yes, there is a double-locking mechanism on all our buildings, making entry very difficult. Wooden doors can easily be broken into.
- 7. What are the exterior walls made of and will they hold up in harsh weather? Our walls are made of T1-11 primed siding, then painted with A100 Sherwin Williams paint, which will last for many years.
- 8. If I use the larger buildings as a garage, are the floors waterproof? Yes, we use BB Oiled and Sealed plywood on the top layer to prevent any water damage.
- 9. Is there a delivery charge? There is no delivery charge up to 80 miles and we are also waiving the oversize permit fee (where applicable). After 80 miles, it is \$4.00 per loaded mile on the 8' and 10' wide buildings, \$5.00 on the 12' wide and \$6.00 on the 14' wide buildings.
- 10. Will the buildings handle a heavy snow load and are they built to code for the delivered area? Our buildings are built to handle the snow throughout the Upper Peninsula, so we are safe wherever we go.
